Dear Mr. BARCOS

Thank you for your reply.

However, I am still not convinced, and I would like to point out that reducing the time of OSAEKOMI and the scale of penalties should not be tested in the competition like World Juniors Championships in Bangkok .

We must take more time to consider and discuss this matter because it is very important aspect of Judo and is a different matter than the Border-Line rules and others.

If we change it that way, it will collapse the essential part of original Judo and it will reduce the value of Waza.

We have asked one of the IJF refereeing commission members, Mr. KAWAGUCHI, about what you said in your email, 'all these changes have been discussed several times with the members of the refereeing commission.'

His answer was that he has talked about this matter with the members of the refereeing commission unofficially, but they did not reach one conclusion.

All the continents who were given advice to give some trials, but they have not given you any opinion or response, which does not mean they don't have any objection to your proposal.

They may not be sure if they should try it or not.

Again, we should take more time to discuss over and over and make decisions very carefully.

I hope you will understand what I am insisting here.
