Dear Mr. Kawaguchi,

Thank you for your e-mail but I am a little surprise about your comments. For long time ago we have been talking in our refereeing commission about the need to improve the refereeing rules and the possibilities to test at the Junior World Championships some of our proposals discussed in several meetings. At the same time we all agreed and committed ourselves to make different test in several regional and national competitions to bring positive proposals for Bangkok . Mr. Roses will come to Thailand with all the minutes from the meetings of the refereeing commission to clarify these issues.

Sorry again but we have not receive yet any feedback, information or result from any test in your continent. In other Unions and especially in Europe a lot of trials have been made with a lot of information and statistics. That is the reason why we would like to have a test at the Junior World and take a final decision after the Championships with the whole agreement of the refereeing, education and sport commissions before any definitive change in our rules.

Our President Mr. Vizer asks me in Tokyo to send as soon as possible this information to every country all around the world and two of the Sport Directors Mr. JeanLuc Rouge and Mr. Vladimir Varta agree with but naturally with the idea to have a conclusion with all the commissions at the end of the Championships and make a definitive proposal to the directing committee of IJF.

However to avoid any wrong interpretation and keep our team work as always has been I have no objection to accept your proposal and cancel the test in Bangkok regarding the time in osaekomi-waza and also the scale of penalties. It means that we keep the actual time for osaekomi and the four shidos as we have now.

Concerning the four shidos I would like to know your explanation about what means the first shido. If is totally free or if there is not any score at the end of the fight this shido should have some influence at the final result if only one of the players has received this penalty. I would really appreciate your prompt answer.

I regret for this misunderstanding and I hope in Bangkok we will do our best for the future of Judo.

Dear Mr. Juan Carlos BARCOS

I hope you have safe travel from Tokyo to your home.

I have got the information about "New Refereeing Rule" for World Junior Judo Championships.

First of all, I would like to tell you that I am against to test new rules of "Timing in Osaekomi-waza" and "Scale of Penalties".

I believe new rule of Osaekomi will reduce the worth of Osaekomi, which is one of the most important Judo elements. And new rule of Penalty has a risk to break a balance of Judo. If we give "Yuko point" upon "first Shido", many referees will misunderstand "Koka should be the same as Yuko".

According to your mail to Mr. UEMURA written on Oct. 8th, you mention that "all these changes have been discussed several times with the member of the refereeing commission".

I have attended all the IJF official events and referee commissions, however I do not think this issue has ever been an official agenda and discussed in the referee commission. In fact, we discuss a lot of referee matters including above rules. But it was private (unofficial) discussion. We have not reached any conclusion whether or not we make a test with these rules in IJF official event.

Another part of your mail "all the continents have been advised to make some trials and give their opinions based in those test", I do not think you have officially requested the trial with this kind of rules.

I believe we should cautiously discuss more before we put these rules in IJF official event.

Dear Juan,

I have received your e-mail regarding the IJF new refereeing rules test at the World Junior Championships in Bangkok 2008.

In your five proposals, I agree with **SCORING, GOLDEN SCORE and BORDER LINE-RULES.**

However, I must say that I have strong objections against **TIMING IN OSAEKOMI-WAZA** and **SCALE OF PENALTIES**.

The reasons are as followings:

TIMING IN OSAEKOMI-WAZA:

My opinion is that the time for Osaekomi should not change at all. If the time for Osaekomi is reduced like your proposal, the value of Judo waza technique will be reduced as well. I strongly believe that the essence of original Judo will be collapsed if we apply this rule.

SCALE OF PENALTIES:

My opinion is that the scale of penalties should not be changed. Hansoku-make should be given to the competitor who has got 4 Shidos as current rule. My idea for Shido is as below:

- 1. Shido = Gesture only (No score for the opponent)**
- 2. Shido = Yuko for the opponent**
- 3. Shido = Waza-ari for the opponent**
- 4. Shido = Ippon for the opponent**

If this new rule is applied, the competitor will only look for penalties and not for getting points with Waza because it is much easier for competitors to get points by penalties than Judo waza technique.

I am deeply disappointed that you have not brought up this proposal while you were in Tokyo . This kind of important issue has to be discussed with the IJF EC members. You just sent us this email of notification, and I cannot take it just like that, without discussing.

We are very anxious about your proposal, because it will make more negative athletes and negative Judo. I do not think this is good for our Judo future at all.
